

Our Passover Seder

Prepare for Passover. Light the Candles.

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, who has set us apart by His Word, and in whose Name we light the festival lights.

Pour the Cup of Sanctification.

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, who creates the fruit of the Vine.

Eat the Bitter Herbs -parsley.

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, who has set us apart by His Word and commanded us to eat bitter herbs.

Eat the Matzoh -unleavened bread.

1. Don't you know that a little yeast works through the whole dough? Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast -- as you really are. For Messiah, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed. *(1 Corinthians 5:7)*
2. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His **stripes** we are healed. *(Isaiah 53:5)*
3. And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and supplications: and they shall look upon Me whom they have **pierced**, and they shall mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son. *(Zechariah 12:10)*
4. Blessed are You, O Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth.

Hear The Story of Passover.

Pour The Cup of Plagues.

1. "But I know that the king of Egypt will not let you go unless a mighty hand compels him. So I will stretch out my hand and strike the Egyptians with all the wonders that I will perform among them. After that, he will let you go." *(Exodus 3:19, 20)*
2. "On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn - both men and animals - and I will bring

judgement on all the gods of Egypt; I am the Lord." *(Exodus 12:12)*

3. Blood! Frogs! Lice! Beasts!
Cattle Disease! Boils! Hail! Locusts!
Darkness! Death of the Firstborn!

The Passover Lamb.

1. We have eaten the **matzoh** to remind us of the haste with which the children of Israel fled Egypt. We have tasted the bitter herbs to remind us of the bitter slavery they experienced there.
2. I, and not an angel.
3. I, and not a seraph.
4. I, and not a messenger.
5. I, myself, and none other.
6. We who have trusted Yeshua the Messiah, believe **He** is the Lamb of God, our Passover. Like the ancient Israelites, we know that it was God Himself, **and not an angel**, God Himself, **and not a seraph**, God Himself, **and not a messenger**, who achieved final redemption from sin and death. It is God Himself, through Yeshua, who takes away the sin of the world.

(Reading from Exodus 12:1-13; 26-27)
